

Colorado Power Electronics, Inc.
Conflict Materials Policy.
October 27, 2013

Several metals that are commonly used in the electronics industry such as gold (Au), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W) and tin (Sn) have been defined as “Conflict Region” materials.

The following are statements describing Colorado Power Electronics (CPE) policy on procurement of materials, sourced from “Conflict Regions”.

- CPE will support reasonable due diligence approach to monitor its supply chain to make sure that materials, used in production at CPE are not procured as “Conflict Materials”.
- CPE uses **only publicly available documentation/policies** from supplier’s web sites to perform this monitoring.
- CPE does not use any materials that could be originated from conflict regions directly in its products.
- CPE monitors if PCBs and solder suppliers used by CPE have Conflict-Free Metals Policies (documentation review only).
- CPE monitors if EEE components suppliers used by CPE have Conflict-Free Metals Policies (documentation review only).
